1.Website

2. Information about your privacy

Your privacy is important to Us. We want to be transparent with You on what personal data We collect, why We collect it, and what We do with it. Moreover, we want you to know your rights regarding this personal data. Definitions

The following definitions will help you to understand this privacy policy:

- "We", "Our", "Us", refers to the ""European Journalists Association-The Communication Network aslb" (EJ) mentioned above.
- "You", "Your" refers to EJ members and our www visitors.
- "Personal data" refers to any information, which identifies You as an individual (directly or indirectly).
- "Website": refers to <u>www.european-journalists.eu</u> as well as blogs and social networks.
- Privacy Policy, are subject to this Privacy Policy.

Applicable law and competent authorities

The courts of Luxemburg, Country where Our EJ Association is registered, shall have sole jurisdiction.

3.1. What information (including personal data) do we collect about you and why?

- Information You give Us: we collect and store the information you provide Us in any way. You might enter such information during the following actions:
 - When You subscribe to one of our events, We collect the data that You will provide Us.
 - If required by Institutions or organizations for security reasons on the occasion of special visits or events We will ask You for ID data.
 - When you provide us an email it is stored on our email server(s) as well as on backup drives or similar devices and/or on paper. The purpose of this being the need for Us to be able to reconstruct certain exchanges of information.
 - You can of course choose not to provide certain information, but then You might not be able to take advantage of all our activities.

3.2. How long do we keep your personal data?

We keep personal data about You only for so long as is necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or as required by applicable law. Regarding the information you give us:

- When you register to one of our events, we keep your personal data as long as you do not notify to us that you do not want to receive any more information regarding our events.
- Whatever date you will provide Us and afterwards You will require to delete, We will do it within 20 days (We will do our best to delete them asap, but we ask 20 day considering that the relevant person might not be available immediately after receiving You request. You can make request at any time about Your personal data stored, or a request for the erasure or correction of certain data.
- However, We will destroy Your data after five years or We will hand them over to you after five years, upon prior request in digital format before destroying them.

3.3. Your rights regarding your personal data

Once You have provided Us your data, either actively or automatically, You will have the right to:

- request at any time how Your personal data are stored;
- request a rectification, erasure, restriction of processing of Your personal data, unless there is any legal objection;
- file a complaint with a supervisory authority.

3.4. We commit to protect your personal data

We are committed to protect the security and confidentiality of Your personal data. We use appropriate technical and organisational measures in such a manner that processing will meet the requirements of the European Union regulations and ensure the protection of Your rights.
